St Mary's CE School Uniform Policy

The school believes that a uniform supports the ethos of St Mary's. It also helps parents by keeping school clothing simple and at a low cost. The Governing Body has responsibilities for school uniform which are detailed here. All children are expected to wear the school uniform. Our goal is for our children to feel included, proud to wear their uniform and smartly represent St Mary's school at all times. The colours are royal blue and white to tie in with the school logo, grey and navy.

For safety reasons - no jewellery, shoes with high heels, platform soles or open toe shoes should be worn.

In February 2015, the decision was made to introduce a new v-neck jumper and cardigan and completely new PE Kit which includes an new PE top, shorts and socks. The rest of the current uniform - polo shirts trousers/skirts/dresses, etc., remains the same. The new uniform changes take effect from September 2015 and all sizes will be available to buy from our current suppliers. New Reception pupils will be the first year to wear the new uniform and PE Kit with the rest of the year groups being phased in over the next few years.

There will be regular sales throughout the year of second hand uniform and plimsolls, organised by St Mary's Uniform Organisers (SMUO), with all the proceeds going to FOSM, with the full support of the school.
