

Sports Premium 2017/2018 to March 2018

Budget provided - £16,945

Spend to date and forward commitments - £11,947.30

- High quality CPD with 'Team V Sport' has continued – 'Elms' carry out CPD for one day a week. This has continued to increase the level of CPD across a range of PE activities. The facilitator was the same person as the previous three years, providing continuity.
