WhatsApp: What do parents need to be aware of?

The minimum age of use for WhatsApp is 16 years old. Young people may find themselves in group chats and could feel overwhelmed by the notifications, the content posted and pressure from others. Anybody in a group chat, even if they're not one of your phone contacts, will be able to see messages that you post, and you will be able to see theirs. You can't always control if you're added to a group chat; but remind children that they can always control their own participation within it they can leave whenever they want to. What is funny to one person, may cause upset to another. If your child is being bullied, sees bullying within a group, or inappropriate content is being shared, then this is not acceptable and needs to be reported. Taking screenshots can be a useful way of saving the evidence.

WhatsApp allows the ability to link your web browser to your child's WhatsApp account – giving you full visibility of every message and correspondent. Simply visit https://web.whatsapp.com on your web browser and follow the simple instructions provided.
