Young Carers

St Mary's is working closely with Richmond Young Carers Service to improve support within our school for young carers.

At St Mary's, we are aware that some of our pupils are young carers. A young carer is someone under 18 who is caring (unpaid) for a family member or friend who is ill, frail, disabled or has mental health or addiction problems. They often take on practical and/or emotional caring responsibilities that would normally be expected of an adult. Research suggests there are at least 700,000 young carers in the UK but many do not realise they are a young carer.

We know that young carers may need a little extra support to enjoy and do well at school. At St Mary's we are committed to ensuring that all pupils who are young carers are identified, and supported effectively. Our Sunday school (age 3 upwards) is a relaxed and fun setting, with a Bible story, prayer, crafts, some acting out or games for the little ones to help stories come to life, and open discussions for older children. This runs every Sunday during term-time (except third Sundays when children join the whole service in church). You are welcome to come to the church hall for 9.25am to be directed to your age appropriate group. Parents then go across for the service where their children will join them for Communion.
