The children will spend this half term finding out about dinosaurs and fossils. This will include learning about what dinosaurs were, the different kinds of dinosaurs, what they ate, where fossils were discovered and what happened to the dinosaurs. If you have any dinosaur related objects or if your job has any specific relevance to our topic we would love for you to come in and tell the children about what you do.
